

The ARES Review system is a peer-review platform developed for reviewers that allows the review of scientific manuscripts conveniently, efficiently, and confidentially.


ACCOUNT REGISTRATION

Enter the ARES website (<https://www.aressystem.com>) and click on **Become a Reviewer** to see a display of the the registration page, as shown in the screenshot below. You can now key in your email address or ORCID Number to create an account.



Email Registration

By choosing to register with your email address, you can directly enter your password, and other information, before clicking on “Continue” to complete the registration and enter the next page (see below) that requires you to fill in additional specific information.



ORCID Registration

If you choose to register with your ORCID Number, please access the authorization page by clicking on the ORCID icon. For new users, this is the easier way to register, as the personal details fields will be automatically populated.



LOGGING IN

Log In

Enter the ARES system at <https://www.aressystem.com> and click on **Login**; then, enter your email and password.



Log in via ORCID

Enter the ARES system at <https://www.aressystem.com> and click on **Login**. If you are already registered with ORCID, you can also access the system after authorization by ORCID.



Log Out

You can log out the ARES system at any time by clicking on **Log Out** (top right-hand corner of page) when you will be returned to the login page.



Forgot Password

Please click on **Forgot Your Password** to reset your password. A new pop-up window will open where you must key in your email address. After clicking on **Reset Password**, a reset link will be sent to your email.

ARES system is a user-friendly manuscript and peer-review platform dedicated to optimizing the submission and review process for authors, editors, and reviewers. It provides a secure and efficient manuscript processing system for publishers. The ARES system allows reviewers to set their reviewing status and preferences, define the time for submitting their reviews, manage reviewed articles, exchange messages with editors, check final decisions on articles reviewed, and obtain access to the final review reports. As an appreciation of their valuable input, *Open Explorations* has introduced a “reward points” program; the points can eventually be exchanged for cash payments.
